Eric Eats Eggs

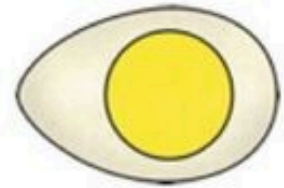

Eric eats eggs each and every day.

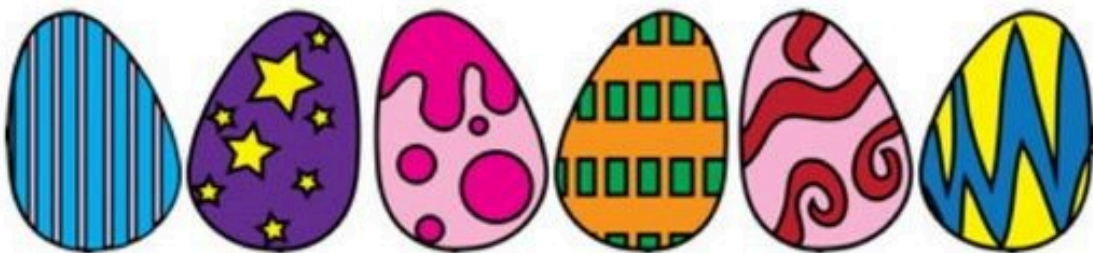


Eric eats his eggs even on holidays.

Eric can not get enough eggs!



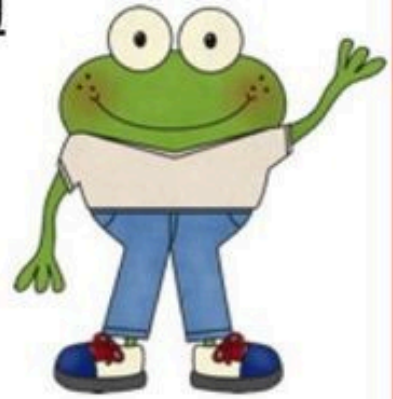

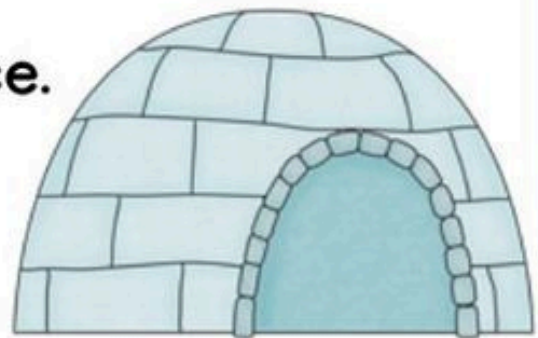
The Igloo

Time to fly her kite again!



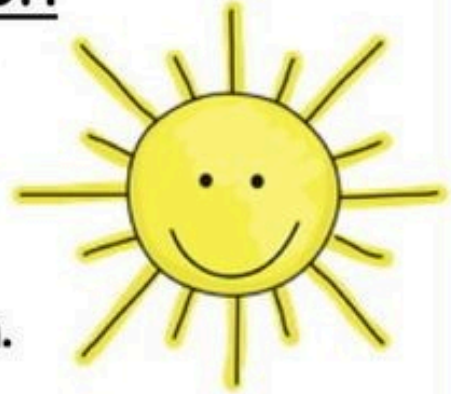

My Mom

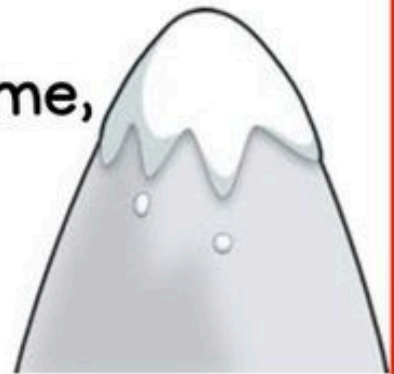

Numu does not nap at noon.

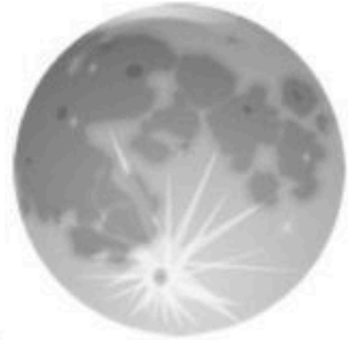
Numu does not snack at night.

He painted on paper.

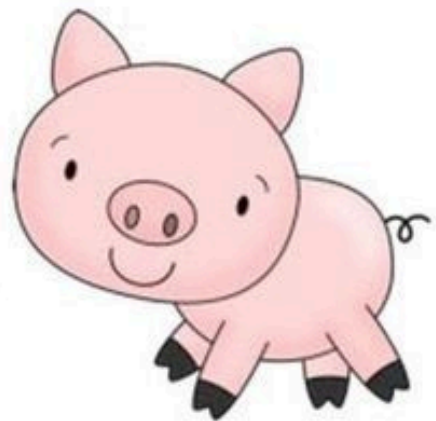
He painted on his plate.

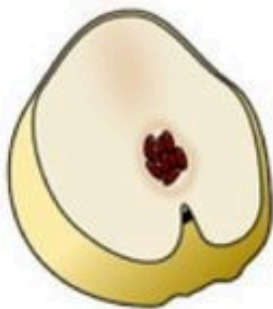
Hungry and Thirsty

Whatever the reason, he loved to race!

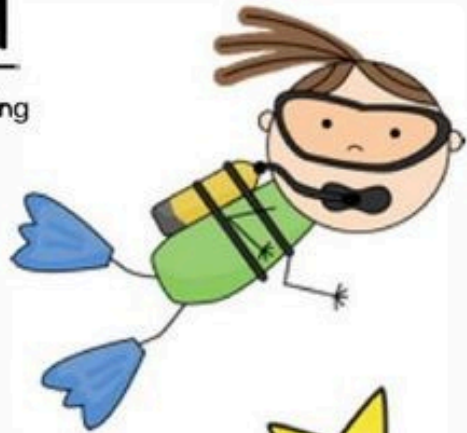

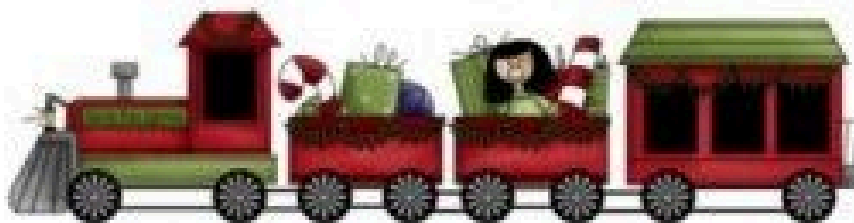
Tom's Toys
